Current WTHJA membership is necessary for WTHJA Year-end points to count. See individual divisions to see which ones will offer points.

HEALTH CARE REQUIREMENTS

ALL COGGINS TESTS MUST BE PRESENTED ON PAPER. NO PHOTOS ON TELEPHONES OR EMAILED COPIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. YOU MAY MAKE COPIES IN THE SHOW OFFICE.

All animals entering the show grounds, whether competing or for schooling only, must be in possession of a <u>current negative Coggins test</u> dated within a year of that competition. <u>It is also strongly recommended that each horse and pony be vaccinated for Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus on a regular basis and records to show within the past 6 months. Requested documentation of current Coggins test must be presented to show management/secretary upon arrival at the show grounds. Back numbers will not be issued without proper documentation.</u>

 All horses and ponies on the show grounds must be entered immediately upon arrival, no matter when you begin to school or compete. Bringing a horse or pony onto the show grounds for schooling or sales and not entering that animal on an official entry blank is prohibited. No exceptions.

ENTRIES

Every Exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. Each entry pays the \$10 office fee and \$10 medic fee and \$25 Schooling fee. Checks to **WTHJA. Mail to: LINDY BISHOP.** There will be a \$50 NSF check fee and

ALL credit card transactions will be assessed a 4% convenience fee.

STALL AND/OR GROUNDS FEE

The stall fee will be \$60.00. A grounds Fee of \$40.00 - for the entire show - will be charged for each horse brought onto the grounds *for any reason* and not in a stall. All entries will pay either a stall or grounds fee. Stall fees will be split between horses sharing a stall (you must let us know in office by Friday at 5pm). Shavings will be available.

NON-SHOWING HORSE FEE

A non-showing fee of \$30.00 will be charged for each horse or pony stabled/or shipping onto the grounds but not showing. Non-showing horses must complete and sign an entry blank with the horse show secretaries.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP

Every entry must pay the \$30 Schooling fee. For the convenience of exhibitors, schooling will be allowed throughout the day on schooling day, beginning at 10:00am -5pm ON Friday (day before the show). Flatting may be permitted in the AM day of show at managers discretion and weather pending.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE

The Horse Show Office will be open by 10:00 a.m. the day prior to the start of the show for processing entries. The office will open 1 hour prior to the start of the show each day. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card filed with the show secretaries. No Exceptions.

RV PARKING

RV Parking is available at a rate of \$75.00 for the entire show or any portion of the show. RV spots must be reserved with **Sarah Jackson: sjackson9136@gmail.com**

CLASSES

Management reserves the right to limit entries, alter courses; prohibit or disqualify exhibitors; change, cancel, limit or combine classes at its discretion to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries or due to acts of nature, without claim for damages.

PROPER ATTIRE

All riders must wear properly fitting, "approved" protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercising areas, the show ring, and while mounted anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place. Hard-soled shoes with a heel (riding boots are recommended) must be worn. Chaps and half-chaps are acceptable.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Sharps containers will be provided in all barns. Please do not dispose of injection materials in the trash containers around the barns.

DOGS

Germantown has a strict "Leash Law", and unleashed dogs are subject to impoundment and their owners fined. The horse show will additionally fine any owner of a loose dog found in a competition arena. Fine is \$100 for the first incident. Second incident will result in animal being banned from the grounds. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

RESPONSIBILITY

Neither WTHJA, the manager, his employees or any other employee of the show will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen, nor liable for any injury sustained to horse, exhibitors, spectators or employees of exhibitors. The foregoing shall be included as a condition of entry.

YEAR-END AWARDS

You do not have to join WTHJA or record your horse to compete in this show.

However, in order to be eligible for points to accrue toward year-end awards for the WTHJA Yearly Banquet, every **OWNER & RIDER** must be members of the association. If you are leasing your mount, the lease must be made known to the membership secretary or points will not count. Additionally, each horse and pony must be recorded for the year. The membership form is available on the WTHJA.com website and in the horse show office. It must be filled out completely so that the points software that we use will work to get you all the points you deserve. THE NAME YOU JOIN WITH AND THE HORSE'S NAME MUST MATCH EXACTLY HOW YOU ENTER THE SHOW FOR THE SOFTWARE TO PICK UP YOUR POINTS AND GIVE YOU CREDIT.

Regarding Covid-19......

We will be adhering strictly to all City, County, State and federal requirements, as well as current USEF protocols for staying safe and healthy during our shows. Face coverings must be worn on the showgrounds whenever you are not mounted on a horse Please use hand sanitizing stations and wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. You may remove masks to eat but keeping your mask covering both nose and mouth at all other times is mandatory.

Keep social distancing in mind at all times, especially in barns and while watching at the ring. Taking your temperature before arriving at the show every day is necessary and if you are experiencing a fever of more than 99.5 please do not attend the show.

There will be no general attendance spectating and riders and families are encouraged to minimize attendance whenever possible. Friends, relatives and other non-essential attendees should stay at home.

The horse show office will be restricted to 2 customers at a time for the safety of staff and exhibitors. Please wait outside the office for an available space before entering. Please remember that inside stable aisles and tack rooms, you must still not gather in large groups.
