PLEASE NOTE STALLS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE UNTIL 2PM
ON MONDAY NOV 3, 2025

Horses entered prior to closing date of October 27, 2025 will receive the early registration discount of \$25 applied to your bill.

Entries will be considered late and occur a late fee of \$50 after noon the Monday preceding first day of show
There will be no refunds of online deposits in the event you scratch a horse due to inability to show. Replacing a scratched horse will not receive penalty or late fee.

Paper entries will incur a \$50 charge per entry.

EVERY HORSE ON PROPERTY MUST HAVE AN ENTRY/WAIVER/BACK NUMBER

COGGINS AND VACCINATION RECORDS:

All animals must have current valid Coggins test on file with show office (copy machine available in show office) dated within less than a year of competition. Vet records of current vaccinations must be provided as well. At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. SEE GR844 for further information.

STABLING/GROUNDS FEE:

Perm. stabling of 260 stalls w/ dirt floors. Stalls are approx. 10x10 w/doors. Bedding will be available and may be charged to your account. Stabling is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Paid stall fees will be charged and will not be refunded if an entry is scratched. Stalls will be \$250/week.

Without prior arrangements, stabling will not be available until 10:00am on Monday prior to show.

A Grounds Fee of \$75.00 - for the week of the show - will be charged for each horse brought onto the grounds for any reason and not in a stall (copy of coggins and vaccination records must be presented and on file with show office). All entries will pay either a stall or grounds fee.

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS

All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Current valid memberships, safesport certification, amateur certification and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Measurements will be conducted on Friday's at 10:00am or by special arrangement. USHJA non members will be charged a \$30 show pass fee. USEF non members must present a one time show pass or will not be allowed to show under rules.

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATION

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (exception: opportunity, academy, exhibition, walk-trot and lead line entries) must be properly registered with USHJA.

NON-SHOWING HORSE FEE

A non-showing fee of \$75.00 + office fee will be charged for each horse or pony stabled on the grounds but not showing. Non-showing horses must pay USEF drug fee and complete and sign an entry blank with the horse show secretaries. Any horses that come to school without proper paperwork and a signed entry blank on file will be charged \$100.00 for non-compliance of the rules!

HORSE SHOW OFFICE

The Horse Show Office will be open by 10:00 a.m. the day prior to the start of the show for processing entries. The office will open 1

hour prior to the start of the show each day. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card filed with the show secretaries. No Exceptions. All entries will be charged a \$100 office fee which covers unlimited adding/scratching and medic fees.

RV PARKING

RV Parking is available at a rate of **\$160.00** for the entire show or any portion of the show. Space is limited. RV spots must be reserved with **SARAH JACKSON** at **sjackson9136@gmail.com** or 440-413-1147. RV Registration must be announced in show office upon arrival. Electric and water provided at spots, pump-out will be at the responsibility of the RV owner, a local pump-out name and number is provided in office.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP:

ALL horses must be entered with paperwork completed/on file with show office prior to schooling. **Official SHOW OFFICE BACK #s MUST BE WORN** beginning at 9:00 AM-4PM on Tuesday Hacking/Handwalking in the hunter rings will be allowed up to approximately 45 min before official showtime (weather pending). No flatting in the jumper ring at any time after schooling day unless otherwise specified with management. **THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOLING (jumping) IN THE RINGS ON THE MORNINGS OF SHOW DAYS.**

CLASSES

Management reserves the right to limit entries, alter courses; prohibit or disqualify exhibitors; change, cancel, limit or combine classes at its discretion to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries or due to acts of nature, without claim for damages.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Sharps containers will be provided in all barns. Competition Management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments per USEF rules.

OFFICIALS

The show committee reserves the right to substitute a show official in the event of failure of an advertised show official to attend this show or perform his/her duties.

PROPER ATTIRE

It is the tradition of the show ring that riders and drivers and handlers be correctly attired for all classes and that horses be properly presented. All riders must wear properly fitting, "approved" protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercising areas, the show ring, and while mounted anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place. Proper attire will be required in all Classics.

FOOTING AND ARENA SIZES

All show and warm up rings are made of all-weather footing of sand and limestone screenings. North ring – 112'x215', South ring – 120'x224', Jumper ring – 130'x250'.

HUNTER AND JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIPS

Hunter Championships & Jumper Championships will be awarded on the basis of points won in classes throughout the section.

1st=10 pts, 2nd=6pts, 3rd=4pts, 4th=2pts, 5th=1pt, 6th=1/2 pt.

All Rated Hunter sections will be combined as necessary according to current USEF rules.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS AND PRIZE MONEY

A trophy and ribbons 1st – 8th will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified. Prize money will be paid to exhibitor by check and mailed within 30 days. Please make sure current address and social security numbers are on file with show office. Prize money will not be processed if a social security number is not on file. **ADD-BACK PRIZE MONEY:** add-back money is paid to 6th place, unless noted in class specs \$10.00 from each entry will go into "the pot" for each class and is divided as follows; 1st-50% 2nd-25% 3rd-10% 4th-5% 5th-5% 6th-5%

COURTESY CIRCLE, JUMP ORDERS AND A "CLOCK ON THE GATE"

A dotted line may be put into effect at Management's discretion. A rotating jump order will be established and posted for jumper classes. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. **If management deems that unnecessary delays have become a problem, a 3-minute clock will be placed on the in-gate of the problem ring. After time has expired, the class in progress will end.**

DOGS

Germantown has a strict "Leash Law", and unleashed dogs are subject to impoundment and their owners fined. The horse show will additionally fine any owner of a loose dog found in any of the rings. Fine is \$100 for the first incident. Second incident will result in animal being banned from the grounds. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

JOGGING

Unless otherwise stated jogging for all classes will result in a trot circle at end of round.

NIGHT WATCH: All horses pay a \$20/week fee. Night watch will happen starting Tuesday PM of week 1 through Saturday PM of week 2

RESPONSIBILITY

Neither WTHJA., the manager, his employees or any other employee of the show will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen, nor liable for any injury sustained to horse, exhibitors, spectators or employees of exhibitors. The foregoing shall be included as a condition of entry. **WARNING:** Under Tennessee Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20. 44-20-103. Limitation on liability for injury or death of participant Except as provided in §44-20-104, an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person, which shall include a corporation or partnership, shall not be liable for an injury to or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Except as provided in §44-20-104, no participant or participant's representative shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or recover from an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the inherent risks of equine activities.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of MEMPHIS HARVEST/WTHJA CHARITY (the "Competition") I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

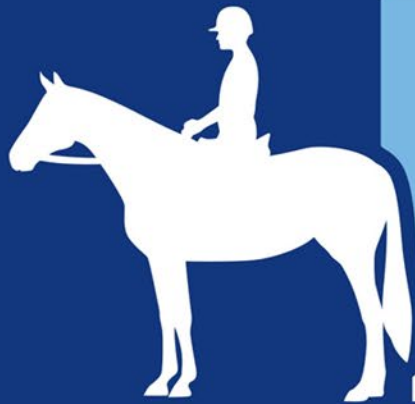

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**").

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER, AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections

Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Riders competing in the Amateur Owner 3'3" section (but not competing in the Amateur Owner 3'6" section) may ride one horse that they do not own in the Adult Amateur Hunter section.

Horse:

Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Fence height:

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- Courses will not be adjusted for ponies.
- In and outs will be permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

May be split into three sections:

- Adult Amateurs 18– 35
- Adult Amateurs 36 54
- Adult Amateurs 55 & over

The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a section, that section must be combined with another Adult Amateur section. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Classics: Adult Amateur Hunter Classics

Four (4) entries are required to conduct an Adult Amateur Hunter Classic. If there are fewer than Four (4) entries in any one Adult Amateur Hunter Classic, it may combine with other sections of Adult Amateur Hunters or Children's Hunter Horse. Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3" (Exception: All Equitation classes and Jumper Classes 1.15m and below). Riders who compete in the 3' Adult Hunters and/or the 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter classes may show horses that they own in the Low Adult Hunters and one that they do not own in the Low Adult Hunters.

Horse and Rider Combination:

Low Adult Amateur Hunter horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes or section where fences exceed 2'9".

Fence height:

- 2'6"

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Low Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Low Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section. If sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

AMATEUR JUMPER

Sections offered and requirements:

- 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper

Competition Management may restrict cross entries between 1.10/1.15m and 1.00/1.05m sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list.

Rider:

Any competitor that competes in any class set at over 1.25m is ineligible to compete in an Amateur Jumper class set below 1.20m at that competition.

Horse and Rider Combination:

1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and may compete with one different horse in the Junior 3'3" Hunter section but may not cross-enter into any Junior 3'6" Hunter or any Jumper class above 1.20m that offers prize money at the same show.

Horses/Ponies:

Horses and ponies exhibited in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Fence Height:

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height
- In and outs will be permitted

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Children's Hunter Horse section may be divided by age of rider. When the Children's Hunter Horse section is divided by age it will be divided: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either age section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. Alternatively, the Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Classics: Children's Hunter Horse Classics

Four (4) entries are required to conduct a Children's Hunter Horse Classic. If there are fewer than Four (4) entries in any one Children's Hunter Horse Classic, it may combine with other sections of Children's Hunter Horse or Adult Amateur Hunters. If Children's Hunter Horse Classics are combined and a horse is shown in more than one section qualifying for the Children's Hunter Horse Classic, the exhibitor must declare their point section to the Competition Secretary on a declaration form at the time of entry into the Classic.

Children's Hunter Horse Classics cannot be divided in any manner and held by section if there are fewer than six (6) entries in each divided section.

Rider age restrictions as found in Regular Pony sections do not apply. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2'0" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the Regular Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers).

Horse/Pony:

Ponies exhibited in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible.

Horse /Rider Combination:

The rider may not show the same pony in the Regular Pony or the Green Pony Divisions. Note: The pony may only be shown by one rider in the Children's Hunter Pony Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic.

Fence Height:

- Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence.
- Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence.

Ponies exhibiting in Low Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible.

Horse/Rider Combination:
